RE: REQUEST FOR GRANT PROJECT EXTENSION

Hafa Adai,

My name is Christelyn "CJ" Ochoco, one of the FY2019 Grant Recipients for my Mental Health Play Festival project. I am writing to humbly ask for your consideration to allow me to extend my project end date from August 15, 2019 to September 30, 2019. There has been great progress so far in this project, but a couple of opportunities have arisen that would make it ideal to premiere the show from September 26 – 29 instead of the original dates in August.

The first opportunity is that the University of Guam Theatre program has offered me the chance to make my project the first show of their regular season, which normally is set for the end of September. The UOG Theatre normally has four shows every year, two in the fall and two in the spring. By working with them to make the Mental Health Play Festival the first show of their season, I would be able to supplement the CAHA grant with their resources including but not limited to rehearsal space, show space, and other production equipment. This would significantly raise the quality of the production. This would also allow the current UOG students to get involved, which I think is a great opportunity for partnership. Not only that, but the UOG Theatre has a history of a steady stream of audience members, and this would give the opportunity for more people to watch the show. Because the message of this show is so important, I believe this is a great chance to impact more people than originally planned for the project.

The other reason I would like to move this project to September is that the PEACE Office has offered their assistance with this project. Since the focus of this project is Mental Health Awareness and suicide prevention, it aligns well with their mission. I have had the chance to meet with the mental health professionals in the PEACE Office, who have recommended that September is a better time to put on the project because that is actually Suicide Prevention Month, and it will allow for opportunities to tie this project in with the different activities that month. They are also interested in helping supplement some of the funding of this project if we are able to tie it in with the Suicide Prevention Month.

I do apologize for not having the foresight to originally set my project to end in September when the grant period ends. After attending the grant workshop last week, I understand it is a bit of an arduous process to extend. I understand my mistakes, and I assure you that I will not make this mistake again in the future. Ultimately, this project just means so much to me and the mission of this festival is near and dear to my heart. I am seeking to make the biggest impact we can make in this project, and I believe that doing it in September would strengthen our chances of sharing this important message with the community.

Thank you for your consideration, and I look forward to hearing from you.

RE: Guam Student Film Club request for extension

Håfa Adai, Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency Board Members,

The purpose of this letter is to request for the Guam Student Film Club's end date to be extended to **September 30, 2019**. The current end date for the Guam Student Film Club is scheduled for June 30th, 2019. However, based on the measures provided in our mid-progress report submitted April 8, 2019 only 49 percent of our student film club members were indeed at risk.

To address this issue and expand our service to our local communities of at risk youth, we've recently partnered with non-profit organizations, Sanctuary Incorporated of Guam and Mañe'lu. (formerly known as Big Brothers, Big Sisters of Guam) Both organizations specialize in at risk youth services and outreach.

To ensure our target demographic of at risk youth be served to the best of our abilities, the Guam Student Film Club will conduct two presentations that focus on sharing the concepts and techniques of filmmaking and media literacy to at risk youth communities. The community outreach and venue location for each video presentation will be determined by each of our community partners.

To allow for production time and coordination for the community outreach we would like to request the end date of the Guam Student Film Club program to be extended to September 30th, 2019.
