VISUAL ARTS – PROJECT DESCRIPTION

To plan, coordinate and execute an educational and instructional visual art workshop for twenty-five (25) school-aged children, ages 7-13.

Art plays a powerful role in enhancing the quality of life through regular participation and generates opportunities for lifelong learning, social engagement and a mastery if skills to new creative possibilities, as well as, promote emotional and physical wellbeing. Art workshops to include the following: watercolor, acrylic, wire sculpting, portrait drawing, rock painting art and turtle art painting.

Dates of workshops must be coordinated with CAHA for a total of fifty (50) hours; must be inclusive of supplies and materials; and must identify and confirm a venue for the workshop. A minimum of six (6) end products per individual must be accomplished.

 - d. Other pertinent information, etc.
