

WEAVING – PROJECT DESCRIPTION

To plan, coordinate and execute an educational and interactive CHamoru weaving workshop for fifteen (15) school-aged children, ages 7-13.

Weaving continues to be an important part of CHamoru culture. For thousands of years CHamoru's have weaved unique and useful items for their households to bags, hats and decorative pieces.

Participants will learn how to select raw material, process and eventually weave a piece for themselves.

The workshop must be conducted on three (3) consecutive Saturday's during the month of September for a total of eight (8) hours per day; must be inclusive of supplies and materials; and must identify and confirm a venue for the workshop. A minimum of two (2) end products per individual must be accomplished.

In addition to the request for quotation (RFQ), you must provide the following:

1. A detailed narrative
 - a. Of what the project will entail; and
 - b. The number of workshop participants; and
 - c. Timeline/ schedule of project; and
 - d. Other pertinent information, etc.
2. A detailed budget breakdown
3. Biography
