Call for Art

(Phase 1 – GRMC Digital Prints)

THE PROJECT:

The Guam Regional Medical City in collaboration with the Guam Council of Humanities Agency invites eligible artists on Guam to submit digital images that will be printed, framed, and displayed at the new hospital.

The total number of digital images sought for this project is 1183, of which 1063 will be printed to dimensions of 16" H x 20" W; and 120 will be printed to dimensions of 3' H x 5' W. The smaller prints will be framed in glass while the larger prints may be framed or printed onto Plexiglass acrylic sheets. The prints will be mounted on the walls of the new hospital in a manner that allows them to be more easily sanitized.

ARTIST'S ELIGIBILITY

To be considered as eligible, artists, must meet <u>all</u> of the following criteria: those who have resided on Guam for at least 6 months; those who pay taxes on Guam; and those who are registered with CAHA. For information on how to register with CAHA visit <u>www.guamcaha.com</u> or call 300-1204 through 8. Eligible artists may include photographers, graphic artists, and painters who wish to submit high-resolution quality photographed images of their artwork.

ARTIST'S AWARD

\$50 for each selected digital image for each print; and \$50 for each additional print of the same image. By submitting an entry to the GRMC *and* if such entry is selected, the artist grants for unlimited use of the work within GRMC's hospital facility in perpetuity in consideration of payment. GRMC reserves the right to determine when to use the prints purchased at its discretion.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

- 1. Artists must include with their submission(s) a one-page resume and fill out a registration form with GRMC. Artists must also submit an inventory list indicating the title of each image submitted and the specific theme (see below) each image intends to depict. Artists are strongly encouraged to submit before prescribed submission deadline.
- 2. Digital submissions of images must be original pieces of art by the artist including but not limited to illustration, photography, video stills, graphic design, or any other technique, or form of art (including contemporary art and fine art). The digital image must be delivered in an approved file with at least 300 dpi at the desired final print size or at least 600 dpi at half of desired final print size. Approved files include tif (TIFF), jpg (JPEG), psd (Adobe Photoshop document), or eps (Encapsulated PostScript).
- 3. Artists may submit as many entries as they wish.
- 4. All images must be suitable for viewing by the general public.
- 5. Digital images will be selected for display from the time of entry through the end of 2014.
- 6. Selection will be made by a Selection Committee consisting of two artists registered with the Guam Council on Arts Humanities Agency, the Mayor of Dededo, GRMC's architect, and the owner's rep.

7. When deciding what to submit for your work, think of the relevance of the image to the users of the hospital. The hospital desires images that are soothing and promote the healing process. Consider also what makes Guam and Micronesia unique: cultures, history, and natural beauty.
