CLARIFICATIONS

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

When submitting digital art, you may submit portrait or landscape styles for the 16" x 20" images. When naming your file, please name your file as close as possible to the description of the image and include "Artwork 1," "Artwork 2," "Artwork 3," etc. before each file name to ensure it matches the registration form that you submit to CAHA.

METHOD OF SUBMISSION

Artists must submit their artwork through USB flash drive. Artists may pick-up their USB flash drives one week after the Call For Art commences (October 22, 2014).

THEMES AND DEFINITION OF THEMES

GRMC has added two additional themes to the Call for Art which will be reefscapes and seascapes. That changes the number of images requested for skyscapes and landscapes and is as follows:

For 16" x 20" sized prints:

Theme:

Skyscapes: 123 Seascapes: 122 Landscapes: 167 Reefscapes: 107

For 3' x 5' sized prints:

Theme:

Skyscapes: 11 Seascapes: 10 Landscapes: 19 Reefscapes: 15

Definitions:

Landscape: A picture that shows a natural scene of land or the countryside. A picture representing a view of natural inland scenery.

Seascape: A picture representing a scene at sea.

Skyscape: A section or portion of the sky, usually extensive and often including part of the horizon that may be seen from a single viewpoint.

Reefscape: A picture representing multiple views of the reef.

Floral: Of or relating to, or depicting flowers or plants.

Historical: Of or relating to history, based on history.

Cultural: Of or relating to a particular group of people and their habits, beliefs, traditions, etc.

Fauna: Animal life, the animal characteristics of a region, period, or special environment.

Artists will maintain full copyright and ownership of their images that are selected for display at GRMC.
